This Office recommends that discussions with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding this pending litigation be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1). Government Code Section 54956.9(g) requires you to state publicly prior to the closed session, what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation.


This lawsuit relates to the Petitioner's application to propose the property at 12244 Pico Boulevard (known as the Chili Bowl) be designated as a Historic-Cultural Monument. Petitioner alleges a Brown Act violation occurred at the June 15, 2021,

Planning and Land Use Management Committee meeting. The Petition seeks a writ of mandate and declaratory relief, as well as costs and attorneys' fees.
