

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that Council AMEND the communication from City Attorney and Ordinance relative to amending Section 10.2.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to raise the threshold at which certain City contracts are required to be in writing during a declared emergency (Item No. 7, Council file No. 20-0347), to include the recommendation below:

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

Section 1. Subsection (d) is added to Section 10.2.1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to read as follows:

(d) During the period of a national, state, or local emergency declared in accordance with federal, state, or local law, those contracts or agreements for the awarding of funds as provided in Subsections (a) and (c) that are necessary to address the emergency, are not required to be in writing for awarded amounts up to ~~\$25,000.00~~ **\$100,000.00**.
