

PUBLIC SAFETY and BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to update the Schedule of Charges for Emergency Services to increase Basic Life Support and Advanced Life Support fees.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated July 31, 2020 to amend LAAC Section 22.210.2 to update the Schedule of Charges for Emergency Services to increase Basic Life Support and Advanced Life Support fees.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 25, 2020, the Public Safety Committee considered an August 13, 2020 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAAC Section 22.210.2 to update the Schedule of Charges for Emergency Services to increase Basic Life Support and Advanced Life Support fees. According to the City Attorney, on June 23, 2020, Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance to amend the Los Angeles Administrative Code by updating the current schedule of charges related to basic and advanced life support transport fees to reflect the current costs for said services, thus an Ordinance was prepared in response. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Public Safety Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. Subsequently, on September 14, 2020, the Budget and Finance Committee also considered this matter and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, moved to concur with the Public Safety Committee. This matter is now submitted to Council for it's consideration.
