COVID-19 and the Mayor’s Safer At Home orders have seen levels of traffic that the city hasn’t seen in years. Major corridors are nearly empty during rush hour as they are underutilized by personal vehicles. This time should be used to expedite street projects by fully closing certain corridors. Wilshire Center Koreatown Neighborhood Council (“WCKNC”) applauds the city’s foresight to expedite infrastructure projects by utilizing full street closures during these days of lighter traffic.

WCKNC **supports** Council File 20-0405 with the following addition: All expedited projects, including those which will be implemented through the ADAPT program, must adhere to the city’s own Mobility 2035 Plan when restriping the street. If the city ignores its own mobility plan, it could be decades before we get another chance to make those corridors complete streets. Los Angeles needs to maintain the vision to reduce greenhouse gases that cause climate change while reducing traffic violence by encouraging transportation methods outside of the personal vehicle.
