

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE
REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the Public Convenience or Necessity Determination
Request Standards and Procedure amendments to the Cannabis Procedures Ordinance.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT by Resolution the proposed standards of public convenience or necessity to approve application processing for license, as provided in the Department of Cannabis Regulation (DCR) report dated June 16, 2020, attached to the Council file.
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance, no later than June 26, 2020, to amend Section 104.03(a), to require that applicants engage with, and seek written input from the following key stakeholders for the area in which the proposed Business Premises will be located, including but limited to: area Neighborhood Council, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Division, local chamber of commerce and at least one substance abuse intervention, prevention and treatment organization within the Community Plan Area. LAPD shall provide the Council crime data for the area, and a letter stating their position on the application request.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the DCR. Neither the Chief Legislative Analyst nor the City Administrative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 23, 2020, your Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a DCR report relative to the Public Convenience or Necessity Determination Request Standards and Procedure amendments to the Cannabis Procedures Ordinance. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the DCR's recommendation, with amendments as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
