Wilshire Center Koreatown Neighborhood Council supports the collaborative efforts of city and county agencies to address the unique needs of our unhoused neighbors during the COVID-19 pandemic. Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority's (LAHSA) unprecedented efforts to bring our unhoused neighbors indoors through Project Roomkey is creating a need to transport people to and from shelters as well as moving meals and supplies to those in need. It makes sense to utilize LADOT's currently underutilized fleet and manpower to fill LAHSA's transportation gap.

However, we ask that the request for LAHSA to assist LADOT in identifying LAHSA's transportation needs be as minimal as possible. We are concerned that this would add one more project to LAHSA's overflowing plate. While LAHSA needs to be involved in identifying their transportation needs, we ask that the heavy lifting involved with Council File 20-0424 fall on LADOT or other transportation agencies. LAHSA needs to stay focused on keeping our neighbors housed and healthy.
