Summary: Forty percent of greenhouse gases in California come from the transportation sector, and environmentalists have consistently pointed to vehicle emissions as one of our more daunting challenges. Yet within days of the shutdown 50% of the workforce was working from home, and 60% of Americans, according to a New York Times poll, preferred it. This cultural shift contributed to the strongest stretch of good air quality in LA since 1995. Let's take what we've learned from this experiment and permanently improve the air quality and reduce traffic. To help achieve this goal, the Del Rey Neighborhood Council supports CF 20-0584 and 20-0498 to encourage continued telecommuting.
