

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Early Childhood Education (ECE) programs and the approval process for child care facilities.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. INSTRUCT the Community Investment for Families Department (CIFD), with the assistance of the Department of City Planning (DCP), Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), and Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS), to create a comprehensive webpage to serve as a centralized ECE hub and planning guide, similar to that of the City of Santa Monica.
2. INSTRUCT the involved City departments to report back to the PLUM Committee with specific recommendations for adoption.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the DCP. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a Special Meeting held on August 10, 2021, the PLUM Committee considered a DCP report relative to ECE programs and the approval process for child care facilities. Staff from the DCP, RAP, and LADBS provided an overview of the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to instruct the CIFD, with the assistance of the DCP, RAP, and LADBS, to create a comprehensive webpage to serve as a centralized ECE hub and planning guide, similar to that of the City of Santa Monica; and, instruct the involved City departments to report back to the PLUM Committee with specific recommendations for adoption. This matter is now transmitted to the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee for its consideration.
