# PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION

The Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) is in the process of extending the Purple Line from its current terminus at Wilshire Boulevard and Western Avenue in Koreatown to the Los Angeles Veteran's Administration Campus in West Los Angeles. As part of this project, Metro requires a subsurface easement through a City-owned parcel of land, Assessor's Parcel No. 4319-003-900, which is in the middle of Santa Monica Boulevard near the intersection with Beverly Glenn Boulevard.

This parcel is under the jurisdiction of the General Services Department, and the Department is seeking Council authority to grant this easement to Metro for the construction of this important infrastructure project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of General Services, with the assistance of the City Attorney, be directed to prepare and present any document(s), including a draft ordinance, which may be necessary to grant the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority a subsurface easement on a City-owned parcel, APN 4319-003-900, for the construction of the Purple Line extension.
