

HEALTH, EDUCATION, NEIGHBORHOODS, PARKS, ARTS, AND RIVER COMMITTEE  
REPORT relative to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Friends of Oakridge.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) to execute a Second Amendment to the MOU with the Friends of Oakridge, as described in the June 10, 2020 Board of Recreation and Parks (Board) report, Report No. 19-206, attached to the Council file, to extend the existing term of the MOU by five additional years.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The RAP reports that the proposed Second Amendment will have no adverse impact on the RAP's General Fund as costs and expenses associated with the preservation, restoration, and support of the Oakridge Residence will be paid by the Friends of Oakridge, at no cost to the City.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on June 26, 2020, the Health, Education, Neighborhoods, Parks, Arts, and River Committee considered a June 10, 2020 Board report relative to extending the term of the MOU with the Friends of Oakridge by five additional years in order to allow the organization to continue its work providing tours and raising funds to restore and preserve the Oakridge Residence. The Board report, attached to the Council file, includes some background on the matter.

After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendation reflected above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
