Summary: The Atwater Village Neighborhood Council supports Council File 20-0769-S2. In a time where permanent housing for people experiencing homelessness is in short supply, and the average time living on the streets prior to being placed into housing is increasing, providing healthcare to our unsheltered neighbors is of paramount importance. Nearly 4 of our fellow Angelenos die on the streets every day, that number can be reduced by ensuring access to healthcare, mental health services, and overdose prevention methods like Narcan. By being more stringent in our oversight of the healthcare being provided to LA city residents by LA County services the city can say in no uncertain terms that the health of all of our neighbors is a priority.
