

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to relative to the property located at 21433 Strathern St, Canoga Park, owned by the Knights of Columbus, to help end homelessness for the City's unsheltered residents.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - O'Farrell):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), General Services Department (GSD), Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department, and request the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to report with recommendations, including funding sources, within 30 days to determine the best use of the property located at 21433 Strathern St, Canoga Park, owned by the Knights of Columbus, in order to help end homelessness for the City's unsheltered residents, in the immediate, short, and long term.
2. INSTRUCT the GSD to negotiate a lease with the Knights of Columbus for use of the property.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO and CLA has submitted a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: Submitted.

Summary:

At its special meeting held on June 29, 2020, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - O'Farrell) relative to the property located at 21433 Strathern St, Canoga Park, owned by the Knights of Columbus, to help end homelessness for the City's unsheltered residents.
