MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council AMEND the Ad Hoc on COVID-19 Recovery and Neighborhood Investment Committee Report relative to a new Council led outreach and feeding program focused on LA's seniors, Item 9 on today’s agenda (Council file No. 20-0862), to strike recommendation number 2 and replace it with the following recommendation, and add a recommendation number 4:

- 2. INSTRUCT the Department of Aging to:
  - a. Report immediately with its cashflow needs to continue the program for the period when FEMA reimbursements still apply.
  - b. Report on the steps required to open a new enrollment period for seniors as well as a new enrollment process for restaurants that wish to be added to the program.
  - c. Extend the meals program through the end of October and work with the City Administrative Officer to report on the cost of extending the meals program through the end of the calendar year.
  - d. Report on alternative program models for senior meals that would be more cost-efficient within a week.
  
- 4. REQUEST that the City Controller take all necessary steps to assist the staff at the Department of Aging to implement an expedited payment system for participating restaurants to ensure that the program can facilitate rapid economic stimulus for struggling businesses.
