

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a pilot program in Council District (CD) 1 which provides incentives and/or rebates to laundromats that reduce water and power costs, to provide economically challenged City residents discounted or free laundry washes.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Rodriguez):

REQUEST the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to report to the Council on the feasibility of implementing a pilot program in CD 1 which provides incentives and/or rebates to laundromats that reduce water and power costs, in order to provide economically challenged City residents discounted or free laundry washes.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has submitted a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY
