

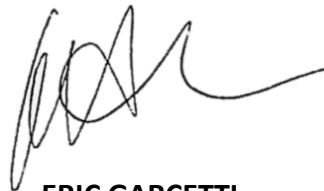

ADDENDUM TO PROCLAMATION

On June 6, 2022, I proclaimed June 19, 2022 as “Juneteenth” in the City of Los Angeles.

I further proclaimed that pursuant to Los Angeles Administrative Code (“LAAC”) Section 4.119(a)(13), with the concurrence of the Los Angeles City Council by resolution, Juneteenth shall be treated as a legal holiday for City employees.

I also requested that the City Administrative Officer take immediate steps to implement Juneteenth as a permanent legal holiday for City employees, to be observed annually on June 19th pursuant to LAAC Section 4.119(a)(13), unless June 19th falls on a Sunday or Saturday, in which case, it shall be observed in accordance with LAAC Sections 4.119(b) or 4.119(c) respectively.

In 2022, June 19th falls on a Sunday. Therefore, I hereby issue the following clarifying Addendum to my June 6, 2022 Proclamation:

With the concurrence of the Los Angeles City Council by resolution, pursuant to LAAC Section 4.119(a)(13), in 2022, Juneteenth shall be observed on Monday, June 20, 2022.
