


MOTION

I MOVE that the Council Action of September 8, 2020, relative to encouraging and incentivizing women- and minority-owned businesses to bid on City contracts, and steps the City can take to ensure qualified women- and minority-owned businesses are awarded contracts with the City (CF No. 20-0943), BE AMENDED to instruct the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of the Department of General Services, Economic Workforce Development Department, the Bureau of Contract Administration and the Chief Procurement Officer, to report with information identifying all City contracting opportunities available over the last two years for women- and minority-owned businesses; the number of these businesses that participated in the process; the number of women- and minority-owned businesses that were awarded a contract; and, on City programs available to promote the inclusion of women- and minority-owned businesses in City contracting.
