

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to suspending all citation enforcement provisions related to temporary signs and allowing them until the end of the Covid-19 State of Emergency.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Blumenfield - Krekorian - Koretz):

APPROVE the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) recommendations as follows:

- a. Prioritize its code enforcement activities to focus on the highest priority issues during the Covid-19 crisis, as noted in the LADBS' report, dated October 14, 2020.
- b. Suspend enforcement of temporary signs during the Covid-19 crisis.
- c. Rescind all orders to comply citations for temporary sign violations that were issued from March 4, 2020 through July 24, 2020.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LADBS. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary

At a special meeting held on October 29, 2020, the PLUM Committee considered a LADBS report relative to temporary sign violations and citation enforcement suspension during Covid-19. A Representative from LADBS provided comments on the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendations contained in the report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
