

### MOTION

On February 6, 2020, the City Council initiated street vacation proceedings for a portion of West Second Street between South Hill and South Olive Street (C.F. 19-1428). The Colburn School is expanding their campus at this site and intends to redevelop this parcel into an open-air amphitheater. The area is currently used as a surface parking lot; however, the Colburn School is seeking to use this area to also engage in pre-development activities prior to the completion of the street vacation proceedings. In order to conduct this work, the Colburn School is seeking the issuance of a revocable permit to use the area for parking, fencing, and other pre-development activities.

The processing of a revocable permit and the pending vacation request will support improvements to public and private infrastructure while maintaining adequate roadway and public right-of-way widths. Adoption of this Motion does not constitute or imply approval of the vacation.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to issue a revocable permit to the Colburn School for a portion of West Second Street between Hill Street and Olive Street in order to allow for the area to be used for parking, fencing, and pre-development activities prior to the completion of the street vacation request (VAC-E1401369) for this same area.
