Summary: The Northridge East Neighborhood Council voted unanimously to request, in relation to Council File 20-0990, that any trainings required of Neighborhood Council Board members also be required to be taken by the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners, the City Council and the Mayor. Council File 20-0990 includes the following: Motion (Ryu for Bonin - Koretz) relative to instructing the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to report with a plan to implement mandatory Diversity, Equity and Inclusion training and anti-bias training for all members of Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils. (August 11, 2020) Motion (Blumenfield - O'Farrell - Bonin) relative to instructing the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to include issues relating to gender identity and gender expression, in its report, in response to Motion (Bonin - Koretz). (January 19, 2021) Department of Neighborhood Empowerment and Civil + Human Rights, and Equity Department joint report, dated March 8, 2022, relative to implementing mandatory diversity, equity, inclusion, anti-bias, and gender expressions and gender training for all members of Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils. City Attorney report R22-0386, dated November 4, 2022, relative to a draft Ordinance amending the Los Angeles Administrative Code to authorize the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to enforce all Neighborhood Council (NC) training requirements and to require anti-bias, gender expression, and gender identity training for NCs.
