Summary: The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) supports the motion for mandatory diversity, equity, and inclusion training, and anti-bias training for all members of the Los Angeles Neighborhood Council System.
