

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority's (LAHSA) outreach experience with persons living unsheltered or unhoused in the City.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Koretz - Buscaino):

REQUEST that officials from the LAHSA and the Los Angeles County Housing for Health outreach teams make a presentation to the full City Council on its outreach experiences with persons living unsheltered or unhoused in the City as follows:

- a. Establishing lines of communication, providing services and relocating them to appropriate shelter or housing, including the number and percentage of persons who reject services or housing or both.
- b. Include data on the number of people who have expressed interest in housing and services but have not yet been placed due to insufficient resources.
- c. Include data on the average amount of time it takes to place individuals into housing and services, should this data be available.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on February 25, 2021, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Koretz - Buscaino) relative to the LAHSA's outreach experience with persons living unsheltered or unhoused in the City. The Committee Chair offered an amendment for consideration by the Committee. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to adopt the Motion as amended. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
