

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT, and RESOLUTION relative to the consolidation and conversion of Temporary Preferential Parking District (TPPD) Nos. 180, 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, 195, and 239 in the Griffith Park area of Council District (CD) 4, into newly established Preferential Parking District (PPD) No. 320.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that the consolidation and conversion of TPPD Nos. 180, 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, 195, and 239 into PPD No. 320 will provide residents with greater access to parking within the residential neighborhood in which they live.
2. FIND that the consolidation and conversion of TPPD Nos. 180, 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, 195, and 239 into PPD No. 320, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.58.d, is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a Class 1 Categorical Exemption, under Article III.1.a.3 of the 2002 Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
3. ADOPT the accompanying Resolution establishing PPD No. 320, pursuant to the Council's Rules and Procedures for PPDs dated November 6, 2018, which consists of the following blocks:
  - a. Mulholland Highway between Woodview Drive and Ledgewood Drive
  - b. Deronda Drive between Mulholland Highway and Rockcliff Drive
  - c. Rockcliff Drive between Ledgewood Drive and Deronda Drive
  - d. Deronda Drive between Rockcliff Drive and Linforth Drive
  - e. Linforth Drive between Beachwood Drive and the dirt road
  - f. Beachwood Drive between Linforth Drive and Hollyridge Drive
  - g. Beachwood Drive between Hollyridge Drive and the trailhead north of Hollyridge Drive
  - h. Beachwood Drive between Linforth Drive and Rodgerton Drive
  - i. Hollyridge Drive between Beachwood Drive and Lechner Place
  - j. Lechner Place between Westshire Drive and Hollyridge Drive
  - k. Hollyridge Drive between Lechner Place and Pelham Place
  - l. Westshire Drive between Lechner Place and Woodhaven Drive
  - m. Woodhaven Drive between Westshire Drive and Beachwood Drive
  - n. Beachwood Drive between Belden Drive and Woodhaven Drive
  - o. Beachwood Drive between Woodhaven Drive and Woodshire Drive
  - p. Beachwood Drive between Woodshire Drive and Ledgewood Drive
  - q. Westshire Drive between Lechner Place and Beachwood Drive
  - r. Beachwood Drive between Belden Drive and Westshire Drive
  - s. Beachwood Drive between Westshire Drive and Ledgewood Drive
  - t. Ledgewood Drive between Beachwood Drive and Belden Drive
  - u. Belden Drive between Ledgewood Drive and Beachwood Drive
  - v. Beachwood Drive between Belden Drive and Rodgerton Drive
  - w. Rodgerton Drive between Beachwood Drive and Deronda Drive
  - x. Ledgewood Drive between Rodgerton Drive and Belden Drive
  - y. Deronda Drive between Linforth Drive and Dorcas Place

- z. Deronda Drive between Dorcas Place and Rodgerton Drive
- aa. Heather Drive between Lugano Place and Durand Drive
- ab. Durand Drive between Heather Drive and Mulholland Highway
- ac. Mulholland Highway between Durand Drive and Ledgewood Drive
- ad. Ledgewood Drive between Mulholland Highway and Rockcliff Drive
- ae. Mulholland Highway between Woodview Drive and Deronda Drive
- af. Linforth Drive between Deronda Drive and 6030 Linforth Drive
- ag. Ledgewood Drive between Rodgerton Drive and Heather Drive
- ah. Ledgewood Drive between Rockcliff Drive and Heather Drive
- ai. Lugano Place between Heather Drive and the cul-de-sac north of Heather Drive

4. AUTHORIZE the following parking restrictions for use on the residential portions of all streets in PPD No. 320 upon receipt and verification of the requisite petition(s) as provided for in the adopted Rules and Procedures for PPDs:

- a. NO PARKING 8 AM TO 6 PM, SATURDAY, SUNDAY, AND HOLIDAYS; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- b. NO PARKING 8 AM TO 6 PM, HOLIDAYS ENFORCED; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- c. NO PARKING 8 AM TO 4 PM, SATURDAY, SUNDAY AND, HOLIDAYS; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- d. NO PARKING 7 AM TO 9 PM; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- e. NO PARKING 8 AM TO 6 PM; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- f. 2 HOUR PARKING 8 AM TO 6 PM; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- g. NO PARKING 6 PM TO 8 AM, 2 HOUR PARKING 8 AM TO 6 PM; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT
- h. NO PARKING 6 PM TO 8 AM; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 320 PERMITS EXEMPT

5. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to:

- a. Immediately consolidate and convert TPPD Nos. 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, 195, and 239 into PPD No. 320, in accordance with Section C.8 of the Rules and Procedures for PPDs dated November 6, 2018, which states that the LADOT may periodically review PPD boundaries and recommend consolidation of adjacent PPDs and/or TPPDs into a PPD where such consolidation will aid in the administration and enforcement of the preferential parking program; and, where the criteria are found to be generally satisfied.

- b. Initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of parking permits to residents within PPD No. 320, as specified in LAMC Section 80.58.
- c. Post or remove the authorized parking restrictions upon receipt and validation of petitions containing signatures from at least 75 percent of the dwelling units, covering more than 50 percent of the developed frontage on a street segment requesting installation or removal of the parking restrictions set forth in Recommendation No. 4, after the consolidation and conversion of these TPPD into a PPD without further action by the Council.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The LADOT reports that revenue from the sale of permits will cover the cost of implementing, administering, and enforcing PPD No. 320. Violations of the posted parking restrictions may result in citation fines deposited into the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on September 21, 2020, the Transportation Committee considered the LADOT report, approved by the Board of Transportation Commissioners on August 13, 2020, and Resolution relative to the consolidation and conversion of TPPD Nos. 180, 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, 195, and 239 in the Griffith Park area of CD 4, into newly established PPD No. 320. On August 15, 2014, the Council approved the establishment of TPPD Nos. 180, 184, 186, 188, 189, 190, 192, and 195, to alleviate the adverse parking impact on residential areas near the Hollywood Sign caused by hikers and tourists visiting the Hollywood Sign. The Council subsequently approved the establishment of TPPD No. 239 on January 22, 2016. On October 4, 2019, Councilmember David E. Ryu requested the conversion and consolidation of the aforementioned TPPDs into PPD No. 320 in the residential area near the Hollywood Sign, and to amend its boundaries to provide parking relief to the residents of the area. During the September 15, 2020 Committee Meeting, CD 4 Office requested to amend Recommendation No. 3 contained in the LADOT report dated August 13, 2020 and the Resolution to include the street segments of Mulholland Highway between Woodview Drive and Deronda Drive, Linforth Drive between Deronda Drive and 6030 Linforth Drive, Ledgewood Drive between Rodgerton Drive and Heather Drive, Ledgewood Drive between Rockcliff Drive and Heather Drive, and Lugano Place between Heather Drive and the cul-de-sac north of Heather Drive.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the subject LADOT report and Resolution, as amended. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
