

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the in-kind donation of \$18,000 for website hosting and maintenance of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) online website.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the in-kind donation of \$18,000 for website hosting and maintenance of the LAPD online website for the Media Relations Division of the LAPD; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 25, 2020 your Committee considered an June 30, 2020 Board report relative to the in-kind donation of \$18,000 for website hosting and maintenance of the LAPD online website. According to the Board, the LAPD online website, LAPDOnline.org, provides vital, up-to-date information about the Department to the public. Currently, this website is maintained by the Online Unit, Media Relations Division. This grant will provide funding for website hosting and maintenance technical support of LAPDOnline.org. The website hosting/maintenance technical support contract is a general support contract, which provides the Online Unit with on-call assistance on a range of issues that may occur in the course of running a website and software of this scale. Types of technical support will consist of, but are not limited to, troubleshooting E-Policing, server assistance, interfacing with Amazon Cloud Hosting for internal and external restarts, helpdesk/software support, troubleshooting and video support for LAPDTV, art theft/development, modification to current and future elements of the website, and website security. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the donation as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
