**Re: CF20-1031 Community Intervention Workers / Safe Passages Program / South Los Angeles Parks / Council District 8 / Funding**

On Thursday, October 1, 2020 the Empowerment Congress North Area Neighborhood Development Council (NANDC) held our General Board Meeting. Agenda item VII(n) called for us to review and consider CF 20-1031. With a vote of 14-0-0, NANDC voted to support CF20-1031 which calls for the City Administrative Officer be instructed to identify \$220,000 in funding for hiring and training Community Intervention Workers for the Safe Passages Program in two South Los Angeles parks in Council District 8 that do not currently have Community Intervention Workers.

The council file informs us that the Safe Passages Program provides an immediate sense of safety for South Los Angeles residents, specifically our youth as they travel to and from school. The additional Community Intervention Workers are essential to the safety of our youth as they continue to pick up "Grab and Go" meals and navigate the increasing number of homeless encampments attached to school sites in the South Los Angeles community.
