Summary: The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) supports the motion calling for a report to Council on the feasibility of applying for Municipal Liquidity Facility loan assistance in order to provide utility related debt forgiveness and rent forgiveness to those within the City of Los Angeles who have been impacted by COVID-19. The economic impact of COVID-19 as well as statewide and local public health orders have exacerbated a protracted affordability crisis. The City of Los Angeles has made efforts to stave off the effects of the crisis, but if/when the eviction moratorium expires, mounting household debt and widespread evictions could result in human, health, and economic impacts never before experienced in Los Angeles. We encourage the City Council to pass this motion and, after proper analysis of the report, move forward with implementation. We fear the consequences of failing to act at this critical juncture would be disastrous.
