


MOTION

The United Way of Greater Los Angeles, a non-profit organization leading the mission to uplift those in need through education, financial stability and housing, is providing a grant to Council District Eight to assist with maintaining a Homelessness Policy position. The position will continue to work with office staff and leadership to support planning and projects related to housing and homeless in Council District Eight and across jurisdictions where relevant. Action is needed to accept this grant and cause the funds to be deposited appropriately.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council District Eight be authorized to accept a grant of up to \$30,000 from the United Way of Greater Los Angeles to support Homelessness Policy staff costs; to cause these funds to be deposited into the Council District 8 Public Benefits Trust Fund No. 49F to be used for Council District Eight salary costs; and to negotiate and execute any document with the United Way of Greater Los Angeles for this purpose, subject to the City Attorney as to form and legality.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any correction, clarifications or revisions to the above instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes to be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
