DRAFT ORDINANCE CALLING A PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020, AND A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020, IN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AND THE LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Honorable Members:

In accordance with Charter Section 402 and City Election Code Section 106, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance calling the City's Primary Nominating Election to be held on March 3, 2020, and General Municipal Election to be held, if necessary, on November 3, 2020. We have approved the draft ordinance as to form and legality.

The draft ordinance calls the elections for the offices of Member of the Los Angeles City Council for Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14, and for Member of the Board of Education of the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) for Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7. The term of office for these City and LAUSD offices shall be for the full four-year term commencing December 14, 2020.

The ordinance also authorizes consolidation of the Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections with the State Primary and General Elections held on the same dates. If consolidated, the County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would conduct the City's Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections together with the State elections, except as provided in the draft ordinance.
