Summary: Whereas in 2000 the voters of Los Angeles passed Proposition F, a bond measure which included 154.1 million to build, expand and renovate the city's animal shelters, increasing the San Fernando Valley's number to 3, Whereas one of the those 3 HAS ALREADY been given to a rescue, Lake Balboa NC (LBNC) supports the reopening and permanent operation of the West Valley Animal Shelter as a full municipal shelter effective immediately regardless of current budgetary constraints. LBNC is speaking for the community which consists of approximately 50,000 stakeholders and one dog park. As of 10/26/2020, there have been 5 NCs and 259 public comments requesting the reopening and permanent operation of the West Valley Animal Shelter.
