

AD HOC ON COVID-19 RECOVERY AND NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the CARES Act funds for the continuation, support, and expansion of the LA AI Fresco Program.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Krekorian - O'Farrell - Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. RECEIVE and FILE the October 19, 2020 Department of Transportation (DOT) report, attached to the Council file.
2. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to allocate CARES Act funds totaling \$2 million to the continuation, support, and expansion of the LA AI Fresco Program.
3. INSTRUCT the DOT to take the following action:
 - a. Make any necessary changes to the program to improve its efficiency and maximize the number of participating restaurants, as well as ensure that CARES Act funds allocated to the program are able to be used prior to December 31, 2020.
 - b. Report with measures to streamline the program for future participants, including standard designs for installation of parklets and a predictable cost structure for different design options so that applicants who wish to participate in the LA A1 Fresco Program may do so at their own expense after these funds are fully expended.
4. CREATE new Account No. TBD, DOT CRF Projects within CAO Department No. 10, COVID-19 Federal Relief Fund No. 63M.
5. INCREASE appropriations totaling \$1,994,622 within CAO Department No. 10, COVID-19 Federal Relief Fund No 63M in the following accounts:

6. TRANSFER \$310,331.80 from CAO Department No. 10, COVID-19 Federal Relief Fund No 63M , Account 10T955, Reimbursement of City Expenditures, to the Reserve Fund No. 101/62 for reimbursement of eligible expenses.
7. TRANSFER \$1,684,290.20 from CAO Department No. 10, COVID-19 Federal Relief Fund No. 63M to Fund 59C, Measure M Local Return Special Fund, Account No. TBD, LA AI Fresco Program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its special meeting on October 21, 2020 the Ad Hoc on Covid-19 Recovery and Neighborhood Investment Committee considered Motion (Krekorian - O'Farrell - Martinez), and the October 19, 2020 Department of Transportation report relative to the CARES Act funds for the continuation, support, and expansion of the LA Al Fresco Program. The report attached to the file, provides some background on the matter.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approved the recommendations as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
