Summary: The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) voted to support the nomination of the property at 1554 South St. Andrews Place as a Historic Cultural Monument (HCM); 11 yes, 3 no, 7 absent, and 2 vacant seats. Both the UNNC Planning & Zoning Committee and the UNNC Governing board had an opportunity to review the draft HCM nomination before it was submitted, see a presentation and discuss the matter with the Applicant before voting. One of UNNC's stated policies in our adopted bylaws is "Advocating historic preservation and restoration."
