

REVISED

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a new citywide assessment district for youth infrastructure and facility maintenance, modeled after the Proposition K program.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield):

DIRECT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), City Administrative Officer (CAO) with assistance from Bureau of Engineering, Department of Recreation and Parks, and City Attorney to report with the steps necessary to create a new citywide assessment district to generate funds for youth infrastructure and facility maintenance, modeled after the Proposition K program, to begin prior to the Proposition K expiration date in order to prevent a lapse in program funding.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on January 26, 2021, the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield), relative to a new citywide assessment district for youth infrastructure and facility maintenance, modeled after the Proposition K program. The Motion, attached to the file, includes some background on the matter.

After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendation as amended and reflected above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
