

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the non-monetary donation of conflict resolution training in the value of \$50,000 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Risk Management and Policies Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the in-kind donation of conflict resolution training for the LAPD, Risk Management and Policies Division in the value of \$50,000; and, THANK the donor for their generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 8, 2020, your Committee considered an October 28, 2020 Board report relative to the non-monetary donation of conflict resolution training in the value of \$50,000 for the LAPD, Risk Management and Policies Division. According to the Board, this grant will provide partial funding for the workplace conflict management training courses for, at a minimum, 60 sworn and civilian supervisors. Jointly developed by the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution, Pepperdine University's School of Law, and the LAPD, this course considers the unique environment of the law enforcement workplace, vertical communication patterns of sworn personnel, increasingly intergenerational workforce, and dynamic nature of police work. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
