

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a comprehensive plan to bring the maintenance and operations of the City's performing arts facilities to field standards.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino - Blumenfield - O'Farrell):

DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Department of Cultural Affairs, Department of Recreation and Parks, and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to report with a comprehensive plan to bring the maintenance and operations of our performing arts facilities to field standards. The report should also include strategies to increase revenues and additional funding sources such that long-term City General Fund subsidies are identified and/or minimized.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on February 9, 2021, the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Motion (Buscaino - Blumenfield - O'Farrell), relative to a comprehensive plan to bring the maintenance and operations of the City's performing arts facilities to field standards.
