DRAFT ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW ARTICLE 15 TO CHAPTER 6, DIVISION 5 OF THE LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ESTABLISHING A REINVESTMENT IN ACCESSIBILITY, INFRASTRUCTURE, AND STREETScape ENHANCEMENTS FOR LOS ANGELES (RAISE LA) FUND AND AMENDING ARTICLE 8.1 OF CHAPTER 6, DIVISION 5 OF THE LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance reallocates revenues deposited in the Street Furniture Revenue Fund, which is renamed in this ordinance to "Council Discretionary Street Furniture Fund." Of the revenues described in this fund, the first \$3,000,000, annually adjusted for inflation, shall be deposited into this fund, with all additional revenues deposited into a new Reinvestment in Accessibility, Infrastructure, and Streetscape Enhancements for Los Angeles (RAISE LA) Fund. This ordinance identifies the City Administrative Officer as the office responsible for the inflation calculation. The ordinance also establishes the RAISE LA Fund and specifies the fund administrator as the Board of Public Works, or designee.
