

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION

MOTION

The Bureau of Engineering has approved an A-Permit to allow the McCoy 255 community housing development in Harbor City to construct fencing in order to limit access to their community. However, the fencing will be erected within the public right-of-way, requiring a revocable permit to allow the community's fencing to occupy a portion of the sidewalk and road.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to issue a revocable permit to Charles Wheeler, subject to satisfaction of the conditions for issuing such permit, to allow for the installation of fencing within the public right-of-way at 25322 S. McCoy Avenue as part of the McCoy 255 community housing development.
