Comments for Public Posting: I am the rodeo manager for the PRCA Rodeo in Glennville, CA. I participated as a bronc rider many years ago. I am opposed to the LA Rodeo Ban for the following reasons. 1. The participants are professional athletes and treat the animals humanely and genuinely appreciate the skill of the rodeo livestock. The athletes are far more prone to pick up an injury than the animals. But if an animal is injured there is at least one veterinarian on site to care for the injured animal. Just as there are medical personnel on site for the rodeo athletes, there are veterinarians for the animals at every PRCA rodeo. Rodeo animals are expensive - both the bucking livestock and the timed event horses. Timed event horses can cost from \$50,000 to \$100,000 and are well cared for by their riders. Bucking horses are bred to buck and draw high prices as well. The Rodeo Stock Contractors do their best to protect them. Many have their own breeding programs. 2. Rodeo athletes respect the country and are patriotic. They stand for what is good in this country. They participate because they love the sport and they love this nation. They are a good example of patriotic, God fearing, citizens. They do not make the high pay that other athletes do - but they respect this nation and what it stands for - and you will not see a rodeo athlete take a knee when the American Flag is presented. You will see them standing with their hats off, over their hearts, honoring the flag. You will see the rodeo begin with a prayer - honoring the God that loves us and has so greatly blessed this country. 3. Rodeo are the only professional sport that is put on by volunteers, not by high paid staff members or team owners. The proceeds from rodeos go to non-profit organizations that care for kids (Golden Circle of Champions - for example - google it), honor our first responders and our veterans, and those who are serving this country in our armed forces. Rodeos are not profit centers for private gain - but are sponsored by private enterprise so that the less-fortunate can be blessed in some way - and encouraged to tackle their fears and accomplish their dreams. Check out the Compton Cowboys, for example. The cowboys pay to enter - they are not paid unless they win. There are no paid second-string players sitting on the side lines. There are no backup players in case you are injured. Its all you and your skills. No substitutes. It is truly and American sport and you have to play and win to get paid. Just like it is in life. 4. Take in a rodeo -

watch the Cowboy Channel or Cowgirl Channel to see for yourself what goes on at a rodeo. It will demonstrate to you the things that I have outlined for you, and may make a rodeo fan of you, just as I am.
