MOTION

On December 3, 2020, the Board of Harbor Commissioners approved a Resolution for a three-year agreement with International Business Machines Corporation (IBM) for the Cyber Resilience Center project with a total contract value of \$6.8 million (Item No. 6 on the Board Agenda). IBM was selected through a competitive Request for Proposals process and the proposed agreement is for the hardware, software, and services needed to design, install, operate, maintain, and support for the Cyber Resilience Center.

The Cyber Resilience Center will be an information sharing system that will enable participating Port of Los Angeles stakeholders to share cyber threat indicators and defensive measure to reduce the risk of cyber threat to Port operations and restore operations in the event of a cyber-attack. In order to allow the Harbor Department to begin implementation of the Cyber Resilience Center as soon as possible, action is needed to waive the Council's review of the Board of Harbor Commissioners' action.

I THEREFORE MOVE that, pursuant to Charter Section 245 (b), the Council hereby RESOLVE to waive review of the December 3, 2020 action of the Board of Harbor Commissioners to adopt a Resolution for an agreement with International Business Machines Corporation for the establishment, operation, and maintenance of a Cyber Resilience Center, as further described in the text of this Motion.
