

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to retroactive approval to apply for and accept a grant award for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-22 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program (IPEP) Grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Administration.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee to:

- a. Retroactively apply for and subsequently accept the grant award for the FY 2020-22 IPEP Grant in the amount of \$125,000 for the period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2022, from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Administration.
- b. Negotiate and execute the grant award agreement, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:

- a. Spend up to the total grant amount of \$125,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
- b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in Police Department Grant Fund No. 339/70.
- c. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments as necessary to implement Mayor and Council intentions, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

- a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$125,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of the FY 2020-22 IPEP Grant funds.
- b. Increase appropriations for the FY 2020-22 IPEP Grant as needed from appropriation account number to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70, to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

- c. Transfer from Fund No. 339/70, appropriation account, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100/12, account number and amount as follows:

4. Instruct the City Clerk to:

a. Place the following action relative to the FY 2020-22 IPEP Grant on the Council agenda on July 1, 2021, or the first meeting day thereafter:

- i. Authorize the Controller to transfer from Fund No. 339/70, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

- ii. Authorize the Controller to transfer from Fund No. 339/70, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100/12, account number and amount as follows:

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations within this report will have no additional impact to the General Fund and will allow for the expenditure of the FY 2020-22 IPEP grant award totaling \$125,000 from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Administration. No matching funds are required for this grant.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations provided in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time grant funding will be utilized for one-time program expenditures.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On March 3, 2020, the Public Safety Committee virtually considered a CAO report dated February 16, 2021, and a Board of Police Commissioner report dated December 8, 2020 relative to retroactive approval to apply for and accept a grant award for the FY 2020-22 IPEP Grant from the United States Department Justice, Bureau of Justice Administration. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations in the CAO report, as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
