

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE
REPORT relative to the 2021 Council recess schedule.

Recommendation for Council action:

RESOLVE, in accordance with Charter Section 242, to approve the following 2021 Council Recess Schedule with the caveat that Council may introduce resolutions to remove any conference dates from the recess schedule if a quorum is expected, as follows:

- a. 2020 Winter Recess Continuation: Tuesday, January 5, 2021 through Friday January 8, 2021.
- b. National League of Cities Annual Congressional City Conference: Tuesday, March 9, 2021 through Wednesday, March 10, 2021 (event held from March 7, 2021 through March 10, 2021 in Washington, D.C.).
- c. Council Recess: Friday, March 12, 2021.
- d. Good Friday and Passover: Tuesday, March 30, 2021 through Friday, April 2, 2021.
- e. Ramadan: Tuesday, April 13, 2021.
- f. Summer Recess: Tuesday, July 6, 2021 through Tuesday, July 27, 2021.
- g. Rosh Hashanah: Tuesday, September 7, 2021 through Wednesday, September 8, 2021.
- h. League of California Cities Annual Conference and Exposition: Wednesday, September 22, 2021 through Friday, September 24, 2021 (event held from September 22, 2021 through September 24, 2021 in Sacramento, California).
- i. National League of Cities City Summit: Tuesday, November 16, 2021 through Friday, November 19, 2021 (event held from November 17, 2021 through November 20, 2021 in Salt Lake City, Utah [November 16, 2021 is recommended as a travel day]).
- j. Winter Recess: Friday, December 10, 2021 through Wednesday, December 29, 2021.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on December 2, 2020, your Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Chief Legislative Analyst report relative to the 2021 Council recess schedule. The Chief Legislative Analyst reports that the dates in the proposed 2021 Council Recess Schedule are substantially consistent with the adopted 2020 Council Recess

Schedule.

The proposed 2021 Council Recess Schedule enables the Council, in accordance with Charter Section 242, to recess certain Council meetings as necessary to attend the National League of Cities Annual Congressional City Conference, the National League of Cities City Summit, and the League of California Cities Annual Conference and Exposition.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the proposed 2021 Council Recess Schedule. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
