ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2021-22 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for legislation to raise the State Supplemental Security Income payment, which would assist the most vulnerable residents to stay housed, make it easier to move others into housing, and help sustain at risk board and care facilities.
- INSTRUCT the LAHSA and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to report on policies the City should sponsor or advocate for that would provide the City with ongoing homelessness funding.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CLA nor the City Administrative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on December 2, 2020, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Resolution and Chief Legislative Analyst report relative to establishing the City's position regarding the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority 2021-22 State Legislative Program Proposal.
