

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 3 (Fong), which would provide that in addition to existing penalties, a person engaging in a motor vehicle exhibition of speed, while participating in a "sideshow," may have his or her driver's license suspended from 90 days to six months.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez - Blumenfield), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2021-2022 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 3 (Fong), which would provide that in addition to existing penalties, a person engaging in a motor vehicle exhibition of speed, while participating in a "sideshow," may have his or her driver's license suspended from 90 days to six months.
