Summary: On October 13th, at a Brown Act compliant meeting, NoHo NC voted 16-0-0 with 4 members absent in favor of CF 21-0002-S165 to support SCA2 which would repeal Article 34 from the State Constitution. Article 34 is a relic of Jim Crow legislation aimed at segregating neighborhoods and has been a major barrier to the development of affordable housing in the state. The City of Los Angeles specifically is in the midst of an unprecedented housing crisis which demands the attention of all levels of government. Angelenos have voted multiple times in favor of allocating funds to the development of affordable housing, but this state law prevents this much needed housing from being built by placing an undue burden on affordable housing developments built with taxpayer funding. This law also serves to further the segregation of our neighborhoods by allowing wealthy white homeowners to veto any affordable housing in their neighborhoods, relegating these developments to already low-income areas, disparaging Black and Latinx residents. It is essential that the city of Los Angeles support this initiative to finally repeal this outdated, racist, and burdensome legislation from our State Constitution.
