Summary: On 01/27/2021, the BABCNC held a Brown Act-publicly noticed regular monthly board meeting and approved a motion of SUPPORT of Councilmember Koretz's Resolution introduced on October 21, 2020 that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2021-2022 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to SB 9 (Atkins), which, if enacted into law would require cities and counties, including charter cities, to provide for the ministerial ('by right) approval of a housing development containing two residential units (a duplex), and a parcel map dividing a lot into two equal parts ('lot split'), for residential use; and exempts environmental review; and would approve these projects without discretionary review, or a public hearing; thereby undermining local land use control and the concept of 'Home Rule' by the imposition of State legislation on local government agencies, including charter cities.
