Summary: On 01/27/2021, the BABCNC board held a Brown Act-publicly noticed regular meeting, and approved a motion to SUPPORT Councilmember Koretz's Resolution introduced on December 15, 2020, that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2021-2022 State legislative Program its OPPOSITION to SB 10 (Wiener) which requires that cities allow midrise, medium-density housing on sites that are either within one-half mile of high-quality public transportation or within a jobs-rich, high-opportunity neighborhood dose to key job centers without affordability requirements or sensitivity to the character of existing neighborhoods.
