Summary: The Greater Valley Glen Council supports the City Council Resolution (CF 21-0002-S18) opposing proposed legislation SB 10 that mandates cities allow midrise, medium-density housing on sites that are either within one-half mile of high-quality public transportation or within a jobs-rich, high-opportunity neighborhood close to key job centers without affordability requirements or sensitivity to the character of existing neighborhoods. If SB 10 becomes law, it is argued that locally approved protections on land usage could be negated.
