

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding the 2021-22 Federal Legislative Program on any administrative or legislative action by the United States government to oppose the agricultural laws passed by the government of India in September 2020 which exploit agrarian communities in India.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez - Raman), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2021-2022 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for any administrative or legislative action by the United States government to oppose the agricultural laws passed by the government of India in September 2020 which exploit agrarian communities in India, as further described in the text of the Resolution, attached to the Council file.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on February 16, 2021, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Chief Legislative Analyst report and Resolution (Rodriguez - Raman) relative to establishing the City's position regarding the 2021-22 Federal Legislative Program on any administrative or legislative action by the United States government to oppose the agricultural laws passed by the government of India in September 2020 which exploit agrarian communities in India. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
