Summary: We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, SUPPORT the motion to support and/or sponsor legislation that would provide funds to agencies to provide fare-free transit in Los Angeles. Reliable and affordable public transit supports our general economy, helps reduce car reliance, and clears our air. Transit fares are often a burden on those that can least afford it, and COVID-19 has led to service cuts at a time when people can least afford alternative transportation. Currently, Metro is considering permanent fare-free transit for its riders. Very little of Metro's operating budget actually comes from fare collection. Free Metro fare would incentivize more Angelenos to use public transit rather than cars.
