Summary: The Greater Valley Glen Council opposes those recommendations made in the Chief Legislative Analyst's report to the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee regarding the 2021-22 State Legislative Program (CF 21-0002-S4) that provide: 1) for exemption to the California Environmental Quality Act for projects proposed under declaration of a homeless crisis; and 2) inclusion of public parks as sites for emergency homeless shelters, with or without declaration of a shelter crisis.
