Summary: On behalf of over 40,000 stakeholders, the Los Feliz Neighborhood Council (LFNC) supports this motion and rebates and tax credits for electric bicycles, asks our state legislators to approve AB 117, asks our federal delegation to approve H.R. 1019, and asks the City Council to advocate for them. Making bicycles easier to purchase will help in the fight against climate change and will reduce the road space taken and traffic violence caused by cars. E-bikes are especially useful for making medium- and longer-distance trips; for journeys uphill, and for some who might otherwise struggle to use a regular bicycle. The LFNC therefore backs incentivizing e-bike purchases through rebates and tax credits. AB 117 and H.R. 1019 will particularly allow lower-income Angelenos to purchase an e-bike that they might not otherwise be able to afford. Moreover, if someone buys an electric car, they get a rebate, but a much more environmentally-friendly e-bike does not currently get the same treatment.
