Honorable members of the Los Angeles City Council,

Empowerment Congress West Area NDC supports Councilmember Mark Ridley-Thomas' motion, 21-0002-s20, to extend Los Angeles City Council's lobbying efforts in support of Assembly Bill 71 (Rivas-Chiu). Homelessness has reached disaster levels in the city of Los Angeles and service providers are in dire need of increased funding. Homelessness also disproportionately affects black and brown individuals; thus, we feel now is the optimal time for our state to invest in homeless individuals as we reckon with our state's history of racism in housing. Assembly Bill 71 would grant \$2.4 billion dollars to homelessness services throughout the state of California.
